SystemOne Tips

The medicines management team has discovered some patients who have been taking their anti-platelets for longer than the intended course length. This is partly due to the complexity of some regimes e.g. where aspirin is for 3 months, with clopidogrel to continue for a further 9 months and long term apixaban.

We have some screen shots below to support how to enter these onto SystemOne. With additional screenshots for courses of ticagrelor.

Journal entry

-  Apixaban 2.5mg tablets - 56 tablet - take one tablet twice daily for life.
-  Aspirin 75mg dispersible tablets - 28 tablet - take one daily for 3 months until 20.3.2020 and then stop.
-  Clopidogrel 75mg tablets - 28 tablet - take one tablet once daily for 12 months until 19.12.2020. Then stop taking these tablets.
-  Prevent repeat template from being reauthorised - Aspirin 75mg dispersible tablets, started 20 Dec 2019
-  Prevent repeat template from being reauthorised - Clopidogrel 75mg tablets, started 20 Dec 2019

If a clinician tries to re-authorise the aspirin or clopidogrel then message below will pop up.



Removing the tick from the “repeat template can be reauthorised” box can also be used for 12 month courses of ticagrelor 90mg tablets when added to repeat for the first time. If the patient is then recommended to continue on the lower dose of

ticagrelor 60mg tablets for a further 2 years a scheduled task can be set for 12 months' time to prompt the new repeat. It is best to set the task recipient as a staff group such as admin, reception or prescriptions rather than an individual person.

 Scheduled Task Creation - Prescription Request task (Patient has completed one year of ticagrelor 90mg BD. New repeat template for ticagrelor 60mg BD for 2 years now needed.) to be sent to Administration on 18 Dec 2020.

Scheduled tasks can also be set to repeat for example as a reminder for a 6 monthly injection and any relevant blood test appointments that are needed.

20 Dec 2019 Scheduled Task Creation Message task (Denosumab injection due in 2 weeks. Patient needs appointment for blood tests 2 weeks before.) to be sent to Administration on 20 Dec 2019. Repeated every 26 weeks.
